Intro: The Names of God given in the Old Testament were based on a deepening revelation of God.

Text: Genesis 17:1-2 (KJV) *And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.*

I. _____ Before El Shaddai and Become Perfect, Complete, Whole

A. Abram's walk with God started out by seeing Him as Most High

Genesis 14:18-20 (KJV) *And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.*

B. Abram acknowledged Him as Most High and paid Him tithe from the spoils of victory

C. Most High (El Elyon): Root of the word is to call one to come up

II. God Desires Above All Things That We _____

3 John 2-4 (NKJV) *Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, just as you walk in the truth. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.*

A. Prosperity Comes From Growing In Truth

B. Abraham Grew Into a Psalm 91 Experience

Psalm 91:1-2 (NKJV) *He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."*

C. By making Most High his covering in the day, the shadow of El Shaddai encompassed him in the night.

III. It All Began With Isaac and the Altar

Genesis 22:15-17 (KJV) *And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time, And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son: That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven*

A. In blessing God with our sacrifice, El Shaddai will bless you

B. When we teach it to others is when our seed multiplies

Genesis 22:8, 14 (KJV) *And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together...And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah Jireh.*
